Vehicle Safety Rules

- * All entrants must obey safety marshals instructions at all times.
- * Anyone not showing a current club membership or have their own insurance must remain static.
- * Vehicle drivers must hold a current appropriate drivers licence.
- * Persons under the age of 17 must not operate any machinery.
- * Vehicles must not exceed walking pace unless in an authorised event.
- * Machinery considered unsafe by the marshals will remain static.
- * Entrants must remain outside the safety fenced areas unless participating in an event.
- * Passengers are not allowed on tractors unless in a factory fitted seat, fender seats excluded.
- * Standing on drawbar or similar attachments whilst the vehicle is being operated is not permitted.
- * Please be aware of the general public at all times.
- * If vehicles are to be moved in the public area a safety officer must be advised and caution must be used.
- * Loose objects on tractors, especially fuel containers, are prohibited.
- * Solid footwear must be worn, no thongs or sandals, and no loose clothing while operating machinery.
- * Refuelling of vehicle must be done in a safe manner away from the general public. NO SMOKING.
- * The storage of fuel must be in approved containers.
- * Vehicles are to be loaded and unloaded in the safety area and the area will be limited to the owner/owners and a safety officer.
- * The use of alcohol is not permitted at any time.
- * Please keep the noise level down to a minimum when not in an event.
